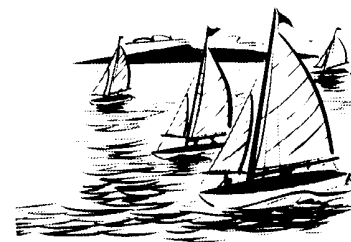

Please do not arrive with dinner in hand as you will need to help set up camp (not have time to eat). Those meeting earlier to pick up camp gear from the Scout Den will be provided with takeaways for dinner.

Return Time: approx - 1730 hrs at the Scout Den.

Activity: **Scouts and Venturers:** The Auckland Area Regatta. Sailing, rowing, canoeing, ironman, camping and seamanship.

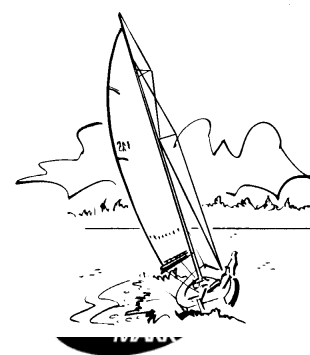
Permission Form: The permission form must be returned along with your camp fee by **Wednesday 17 March**. Cheques are to be made out to: "New Lynn Scout Group".
