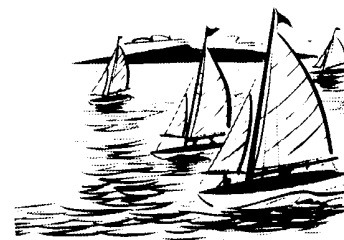

- Date:** Easter, 2 – 5 April, 2010
- Meeting Place:** The New Lynn Scout Den
- Meeting Time:** 1000hrs - To be confirmed once after 10 March (intention forms due).
This is a long trip so we are likely to leave about 1000hrs on the Friday. No camp to set up as we will be sleeping in local Scout Halls and all catering will be done for us, so less gear to take.
- Return Time:** 1600 hrs at the Scout Den on the Monday – to be confirmed.
- Activity:** The Cutty Sark Regatta. Sailing, rowing, canoeing, ironman, seamanship and the caterpillar race. *Fun, fun, fun, fun ...*

If you need transport then you are required to pay an additional **\$20 each way** to go towards petrol costs. Petrol money to be paid direct to the driver.

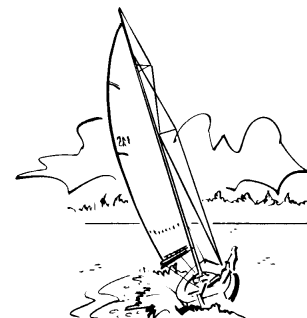
You will need to bring some money to pay for lunch and dinner on Friday and Monday nights depending on your travel times. A packed lunch is recommended for the Friday.

- What to wear:** New Lynn activity shirt for travelling to and from camp.
- Parent help:** We will require help from parents to transport Scouts and gear to and from the regatta. Any parents assisting with towing boats will be paid a petrol subsidy towards petrol costs from the Lottery Training Grant. Any parent driving will not be required to pay the regatta fee (one credit per vehicle). A fuel subsidy is intended to be paid, funds depending.
